# OFF TO SCHOOL

Transitioning from the Early Learning and Care (ELC) Setting to Primary School

#### **Skills:**

- Putting on/off coat
- Putting shoes on/off
- Open lunchbox/drink/pencil case/school bag

### **Knowledge & Understanding:**

- Teacher's name
- Two lunch breaks



#### **Be Practical:**

- Velcro shoes
- Easy to open lunchbox and drink
- Healthy lunches
- Early nights in bed

## Language:

- It's not 'BIG SCHOOL'; this can be scary for the child. Use 'primary school'
- Let children express their emotions, and listen
- Don't impress your own fears or memories from school onto children

# Collaborative Practice:

- Work in partnership with parents.
  This is a process of transition for parents also
- Transfer documentation with parental consent
- Inform the school of children strengths, interests and needs with parental consent

## **Experiences:**

- School props in the ELC setting for children to play with/explore
  - School bag/pencil case/lunchbox/uniforms for dress up
- Books e.g. photo books of the primary school
- Stories about transitioning to primary school
