Westmeath Community Development (WCD) is recruiting for Childcare worker in Castlepollard.

Key Areas of Work

- o Responsible for the day-to-day delivery of Afterschool services including:
 - Accompanying children to and from school and any other relevant venue or activities
 - Supervising homework activities
 - Providing meals to children
 - Collecting fees from parents
 - Ensuring a high standard of hygiene in the Afterschool centre
- o Ensure that child protection procedures are adhered to and advise Lead Childcare worker regarding any concerns about a child.
- o Ensure the overall safety and well-being of children.
- o Maintain strict confidentiality regarding children and their families.
- o Support Lead Childcare worker with registrations/allocation of places/providing progress updates to parents/maintaining attendance records.
- O Contribute to the planning of daily age appropriate activities of the Afterschool service including the development and implementation of a quality curriculum.
- o Maintain room and equipment to ensure the health and safety of children at all times.
- o Assist the Lead Childcare worker to implement the Quality and Regulatory Framework (QRF) and associated recommendations following a Tusla inspection.
- o Assist the Lead Childcare worker & Childcare Manager to regularly update, review, and implement all WCD Afterschool service policies and procedures (including but not exclusive to child protection, health & safety, GDPR, fire safety, fee collection).
- o Attend and engage in weekly staff meetings and undergo training as required.
- o Perform other reasonable and relevant duties as may be assigned from time to time and as prescribed by regulations.
